MISSION

DTRA provides cross-cutting solutions to enable the Department of Defense, the United States Government, and international partners to **Deter** strategic attack against the United States and its allies; **Prevent**, reduce, and counter WMD and emerging threats; and **Prevail** against WMD-armed adversaries in crisis and conflict



SOLICITATION PROCESS

Basic and transparent 2-step process:

- 1) Call for white papers to describe the technology transfer along with an endorsement from a DTRA Program Manager, Subject Matter Expert, Department or Directorate head stating that the technology transfer will help address a one of their top priorities.
- 2) A request for proposal (RFP) by invitation to only those Mentor-Protégé (MP) teams whose technology transfer we wish to pursue.



Mentor-Protégé Program

- Designed to encourage large business prime contractor firms to provide mutually beneficial developmental assistance to small businesses
- Mentor-Protégé Agreement (MPA) types:
 - Reimbursable; 5% of costs must be subcontracted to
 - Historically Black College or University (HBCU) / Minority Serving Institute (MSI)
 - Small Business Developments Center (SBDC)
 - Apex Accelerator (formerly PTAC)
 - Credit
 - Hybrid



MPP Developmental Assistance

- Examples of some technical assistance provided:
 - Human Resources training and certifications
 - Marketing training; website design; branding
 - PMP training and certification
 - Additive manufacturing improvements
 - ISO certifications
 - CMMI training and certification
 - Implementing an DCAA-approved (i.e. Defense Contracting Auditing Agency) accounting system
 - Providing student interns for some of the technology transfer/development
 - Others
